

# John Lawrence Hochstatter

## 29<sup>th</sup> State Deputy of Oregon 1964-1965



John Lawrence Hochstatter was born on September 7, 1921 in Salina, KS to John and Sarah Grety Hochstatter.

John worked in a bakery in Salina, KS until he relocated to Oregon about 1942 when he joined the Coast Guard and was discharged in 1945. John married Marjorie Warmuth on July 25, 1944 in Hood River, OR. They had six children: John Jr., Peter, Daniel, Mary Kay, Barbara, and Margaret. The family relocated to Medford, OR.



John graduated from the University of Portland in 1950 with a degree in Business.

John was a member of the Medford council, 1594. He was Faithful Navigator of his Assembly and District Deputy. John was elected State Deputy in 1964 but never held any other State Office.

Later in life John and his family moved to Langley, WA

John L. Hochstatter died on April 9, 1982 in Langley, WA and is buried in the Saint John Apostle Catholic Cemetery in Oregon City, OR. Marjorie died in 1991 and is buried next to John.
