

Johnnie Stewart Doubleday

35th State Deputy of Oregon 1975-1977



John Stewart Doubleday was born on March 10, 1928 in Meeteetse, WY to John and Laura Brown Doubleday. He graduated from San Diego High School. He received College Credits in Electrical and Electronic Engineering.

Johnnie married Shirley Jensen on February 23, 1947 in Roosevelt UT. Shortly after the couple divorced.

Johnnie joined the Navy and served in the Korean War. Johnnie married Joan Fitzgerald on May 26, 1951 in Billings, MT. The couple had three children: Joan, Jann and Janet. The family moved to The Dalles, OR in 1956. In 1959 Johnnie converted to the Catholic Faith.

In 1961 Johnnie joined the Knights of Columbus and became a member of The Dalles Council 1598. He was the Grand Knight of the Council in 1964 and the same year instituted the Fruit Pickup for the St. Mary's Home for Boys. He served as District Deputy from 1966–1968. He was the State Convention Chairman from 1971-1972.

Johnnie was a member of the Elks Lodge 303 in The Dalles and was Elk of the year 1970-1971. He served as Exalted Ruler of the Elks 1973-1974. Johnnie was elected State Deputy in 1975 but never held any other State Office. In 1980 he became District Master of the Fourth Degree.

John S. Doubleday died September 23, 2009 in his winter residence in Casa Grande, AZ and unsure of his burial location. Joan died in 2002
