

Rev. John M. Sheridan

16th State Chaplain of Oregon 1941-42



John M. Sheridan was born in 1874 in Leitrim, Ireland to Philip and Margaret Sheridan. He arrived in Oregon in 1898.

Rev. Sheridan was the pastor St. Monica's at Coos Bay from 1923 until 1941 until he was transferred to St. John's in Oregon City. He was the pastor at St. John's until his death.

He was Knights of Columbus State Chaplain 1941-42. He did not attend the only State Convection while he was State Chaplain in 1941 in Hillsboro due to his health.

Rev. John M. Sheridan died August 29, 1946 in Oregon City, OR. He is buried at the Mount Calvary Cemetery in Portland, OR.
