

Fourth Degree Knights in the Community

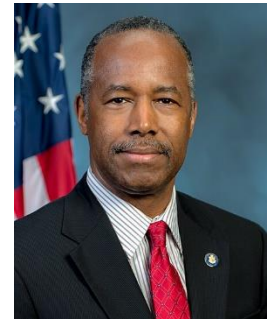
Assembly 905, Very Reverend Francis W Black in Medford does more than Color Guard Events.

“Dr. Ben Carson Sr., M.D. is Founder and Chairman of the American Cornerstone Institute whose mission is to promote 4 founding principles: faith, liberty, community, and life. He recently served as the 17th Secretary of the US Department of Housing and Urban Development and served nearly 30 years as the Director of Pediatric Neurosurgery at Johns Hopkins Children's Center, a position he assumed at just 33 years old, the youngest major division director in the hospital's history. Dr. Carson has received many accolades and awards in recognition for his achievements in advanced medicine, including the Presidential Medal of Freedom, our nation's highest civilian honor. He is the author of 9 books, 4 of which were co-written with his wife Candy. Dr. & Mrs. Carson established the Carson Scholars Fund, which recognizes young people of all backgrounds for exceptional academic and humanitarian accomplishments. Part of Dr. Carson's life story can be seen in the movie 'Gifted Hands'. Dr. & Mrs. Carson are the proud parents of three adult sons and 8 grandchildren.”
